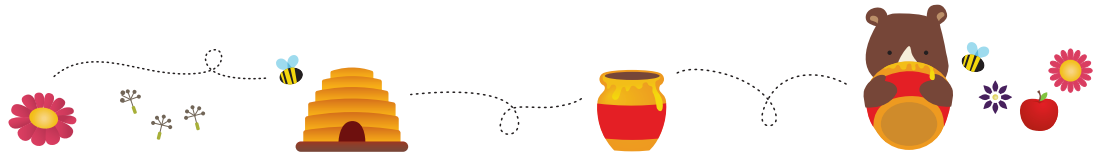
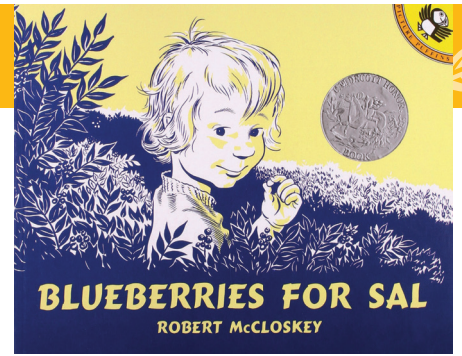

- Develop an awareness of the presence of God in creation and our relationships with others.

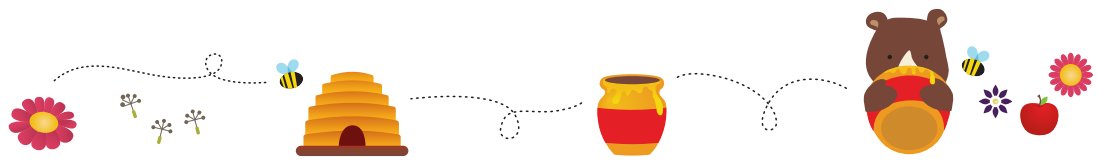
